*European Science Editing* is the journal of the European Association of Science Editors and is published quarterly.

The European Association of Science Editors (**EASE**) was formed in 1982 from the amalgamation of the European Life Science Editors' association, ELSE, and the European Association of Earth Science Editors, Editerra. The first meeting was held at Pau, France, in May 1982. Since then the three-yearly conference has taken place in Oslo, Basle, Oxford, Budapest, Helsinki, Tours and Bath. In 2006 the Conference was held in Krakow, Poland.

Membership now covers more than 50 countries, with the majority of members in Europe, including 180 Chief Editors, with a further 217 Deputy and Assistant Chief Editors. Other members' jobs range from copy and author's editor, translator, managing editor, librarian to indexer, with over 100 freelance members, some of whom are also trainers. English is the official language of the Association. **EASE** promotes improved communication in science by encouraging its members to share their skills. Membership is open to editors of publications in any science, and to those involved in the editorial and production work for journals and books, and writers on scientific subjects. Also welcome are those working in other branches of scientific communication, for example: translation, abstracting services, indexing, science writing, librarians and those involved in the training of science editors and writers.

**EASE** activities include an international conference every third year, meetings with other editorial and science writing organisations, symposia and workshops. From time to time joint meetings are held with the Council of Science Editors and the Association of Earth Science Editors, (USA). **EASE** was a participant in the CER2005 at Brussels.

Apart from its journal, *European Science Editing*, **EASE** publishes the *Science Editors' Handbook*. The 56 revised chapters, published since June 2003, are free to members and available for purchase by non-members via the web site, [www.ease.org.uk](http://www.ease.org.uk). This also has links to a wide range of sites of interest to science editors and provides up-to-date information. An active web forum encourages a free exchange of ideas, problem solving and shared experience.

**EASE** is a non-governmental and not-for-profit organisation operated exclusively for the advancement of science editing and for educational purposes. The affairs of the Association are administered by the General Assembly, and on behalf of the General Assembly by the Council.
